AN ACT ESTABLISHING A TASK FORCE TO STUDY ALTERNATIVE FUNDING SOURCES FOR NUTRITIONAL SERVICES FOR SENIORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 17b of the general statutes be amended to establish a task
- 2 force to study alternate funding sources for nutritional services for
- 3 seniors, including, but not limited to, private funding. Members of the
- 4 task force shall include, but not be limited to: (1) A member of the joint
- 5 standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of
- 6 matters relating to aging, (2) representatives of area agencies on aging,
- 7 (3) a representative from the Department of Social Services, and (4) a
- 8 representative from the Department on Aging.

Statement of Purpose:

To study alternate funding sources for nutrition programs for the elderly.
