**AN ACT CONCERNING CARE FOR ELDERLY PERSONS IN A HOME SETTING RATHER THAN A HEALTH CARE FACILITY.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 368v of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Commissioner of Public Health to develop a plan to ensure that, on
- 3 and after December 31, 2015, not less than seventy-five per cent of
- 4 elderly persons who require long-term care receive such care in a
- 5 home setting rather than a nursing home facility.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To promote aging in place by developing a plan to ensure seventy-five per cent of elderly persons requiring long-term care receive such care in a home setting by the end of 2015.
