AN ACT CONCERNING SWIMMING IN CERTAIN BODIES OF WATER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 440 of the general statutes be amended to allow
- 2 swimming in any body of water where flood-skimming is used to
- 3 transfer excess water from the body of water to a distribution reservoir
- 4 during periods when flood-skimming is not occurring, provided
- 5 swimming has been permitted in the body of water for not less than
- 6 fifty years.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow swimming in certain bodies of water where it has historically been permitted.
