AN ACT PROVIDING INCENTIVES FOR GAS STATIONS AND GROCERY STORES TO PURCHASE EMERGENCY GENERATORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to provide incentives for gas
- 2 stations and grocery stores to purchase emergency generators, by
- 3 creating a program offering low interest state loans to such businesses
- 4 for such purchases and by establishing a ten per cent exemption on the
- 5 property tax of the generator for the first five years following
- 6 purchase.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide incentives for certain retailers to purchase emergency generators to keep vital businesses open during a period of loss of power.
