**AN ACT REQUIRING THE COMMISSIONER OF CONSUMER PROTECTION TO UNDERTAKE A STUDY OF OCCUPATIONAL LICENSES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Commissioner
- 2 of Consumer Protection to undertake a study of all occupational
- 3 licenses and recommend elimination of those licenses that are not
- 4 necessary to protect the public health or safety.

To provide relief to individuals and small businesses by eliminating unnecessary regulatory burdens.
