**AN ACT CONCERNING CONSUMER PROTECTION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective January 1, 2014*) The Commissioner of
- 2 Consumer Protection shall adopt regulations, in accordance with the
- 3 provisions of chapter 54 of the general statutes, to protect consumers
- 4 from unfair business practices.
