AN ACT ESTABLISHING A PILOT PROGRAM TO ALLOW HOMELESS SHELTERS TO PROVIDE RECUPERATIVE CARE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to establish a pilot program in
- 2 the cities of Bridgeport, Danbury, Hartford and New Haven that
- 3 would allow local homeless shelters to provide recuperative care for
- 4 homeless individuals discharged from hospitals.

Statement of Purpose:

To create a twenty-four-hour recuperative care pilot program for the homeless.
