**AN ACT CONCERNING THE JEOPARDY TAX COLLECTION ON  
MOTOR VEHICLES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that a person who
- 2 has previously been delinquent on a property tax payment for a motor
- 3 vehicle may register their motor vehicle so long as their taxes are paid
- 4 at the time of registration, and to further provide that such persons
- 5 shall not be required to pay such property taxes in advance in order to
- 6 register a motor vehicle.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To remove the jeopardy tax collection on motor vehicles.
