AN ACT CONCERNING A PHASE-IN OF THE DATE ON WHICH A CHILD MUST TURN FIVE YEARS OLD IN ORDER TO ENROLL IN KINDERGARTEN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-15c of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 that any child enrolled in kindergarten reach age five on or before (1)
- 3 December first for the school year commencing July 1, 2013, (2)
- 4 November first for the school year commencing July 1, 2014, (3)
- 5 October first for the school year commencing July 1, 2015, and (4)
- 6 September first for the school year commencing July 1, 2016.

Statement of Purpose:

To phase in the cut-off date for when a child must turn five years of age in order to enroll in kindergarten for such school year.
