**AN ACT REQUIRING INPUT FROM LOCAL MANUFACTURERS IN
DEVELOPING MANUFACTURING TECHNOLOGY PROGRAMS AT
THE REGIONAL COMMUNITY-TECHNICAL COLLEGES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require each regional
- 2 community-technical college to obtain input specific to the workforce
- 3 needs and opportunities of such college's service area from local
- 4 manufacturers on developing, revising or expanding such college's
- 5 manufacturing technology program.
