**AN ACT CONCERNING ACCESS TO THE MEDICAL RECORDS OF A  
DECEASED PERPETRATOR OF HOMICIDE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to establish a judicial process
- 2 by which the next of kin of a homicide victim may petition the court
- 3 for a limited release of certain medical and psychiatric records relating
- 4 to a deceased perpetrator of the homicide.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To establish a judicial process that allows the next of kin of a homicide  
victim to seek limited access to the medical and psychiatric records of  
the deceased perpetrator of the homicide.
