**AN ACT CONCERNING THE PRETRIAL COMMUNITY SERVICE
LABOR PROGRAM.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 53a-39c of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 that a person may participate in the pretrial community service labor
- 3 program more than once without entering a guilty plea if such person
- 4 has paid all program fees or had such fees waived, has satisfactorily
- 5 completed the program each time such person has previously
- 6 participated in the program, and has otherwise complied with all
- 7 orders of the court.

Statement of Purpose:

To permit a defendant to use the pretrial community service labor program multiple times if the defendant has previously complied with all program conditions.
