**AN ACT CONCERNING THE MINIMUM AGE REQUIREMENT TO  
PURCHASE A RIFLE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to clarify that an individual
- 2 must be twenty-one years of age or older, rather than eighteen years of
- 3 age or older as currently allowed, to purchase a rifle in order to make
- 4 such minimum age consistent with the minimum age to purchase a
- 5 pistol or revolver.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To clarify that an individual must be twenty-one years of age or older in order to purchase a rifle.
