***AN ACT CONCERNING ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT
APPROPRIATIONS.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 31-3kk of the general statutes is repealed and the
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2013*):

3 Any funds appropriated to the Labor Department for incumbent
4 worker training programs shall be administered by [regional
5 workforce development boards] the Labor Commissioner and such
6 programs shall be implemented by the regional workforce
7 development boards. Not later than October 1, 2015, and annually
8 thereafter, the Labor Commissioner shall submit a report, in
9 accordance with section 11-4a, to the joint standing committees of the
10 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to commerce
11 and labor on the expenditure of such funds and the outcomes of such
12 programs for companies and their employees.

13 Sec. 2. (*Effective July 1, 2013*) The sum of five hundred thousand
14 dollars is appropriated to the Labor Department from the General
15 Fund, for each of the fiscal years ending June 30, 2014, and June 30,

16 2015, for the incumbent worker training programs. Any funds
 17 appropriated for the 21st Century Jobs program for said fiscal years
 18 shall be included in the Incumbent Worker Training account of the
 19 Labor Department.

20 Sec. 3. (*Effective July 1, 2013*) The sum of one million five hundred
 21 thousand dollars is appropriated to the Department of Economic and
 22 Community Development, from the General Fund, for the fiscal year
 23 ending June 30, 2014, for the purpose of providing a grant-in-aid to the
 24 Consortium of Connecticut Art Museums in order to fund its
 25 operations.

26 Sec. 4. (*Effective July 1, 2013*) The sum of ten million dollars is
 27 appropriated to the Department of Economic and Community
 28 Development, from the General Fund, for the fiscal year ending June
 29 30, 2014, for the purpose of providing a grant-in-aid to the town of
 30 Preston and the city of Norwich to remediate and redevelop the
 31 Norwich State Hospital property.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Statement of Purpose:

To provide funding for the Consortium of Connecticut Art Museums, the redevelopment of the Norwich State Hospital property and the Labor Department's incumbent worker training programs, and to require the Labor Department to provide an annual report concerning the expenditure of such funds.
