AN ACT REQUIRING CERTAIN STATE AND LOCAL POLICE TO RECEIVE TRAINING ON THE MANAGEMENT OF ESCAPED LIVESTOCK.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require state and local
- 2 police in agricultural communities to receive training on how to
- 3 effectively manage escaped livestock.

Statement of Purpose:

To enable first responders to better ensure public safety and minimal harm to livestock that may escape their confines.
