**AN ACT REESTABLISHING THE INDEPENDENCE OF THE OFFICE OF
STATE ETHICS, STATE ELECTIONS ENFORCEMENT COMMISSION
AND FREEDOM OF INFORMATION COMMISSION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to remove the Office of State
- 2 Ethics, the State Elections Enforcement Commission and the Freedom
- 3 of Information Commission from the Office of Government
- 4 Accountability and to reestablish them as independent agencies.
