AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEFINITION OF ASSAULT WEAPON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That section 53-202a of the general statutes be amended to expand
2 the definition of "assault weapon" by: (1) Updating the physical
3 characteristics of an assault weapon set forth in subparagraph (3) of
4 subsection (a) of said section; (2) including all weapons that are
5 "copycats" or functionally equivalent to the weapons named in the
6 definition of "assault weapon"; and (3) designating as "assault
7 weapons" several additional specifically named weapons and their
8 equivalent types, including, but not limited to, the Armalite AR-10,
9 M15 or Golden Eagle types; Bushmaster AR-15 or XM15 types; Colt
10 AR-10 or Match Target types; DPMS Panther type; DS Arms SA 58
11 type; Eagle Arms M15 or EA-15 types; Fulton Armory AR-15 type;
12 Hesse Arms HAR 15A2 or HAR-25 types; Intratec TEC DC-9 or AB-10
13 types, Knight's SR-15, SR-25, or RAS types; Les Baer Ultimate AR type;
14 Olympic Arms AR-15, Car-97 or PCR types; Professional Ordinance,
15 Inc. Carbon 15 rifle or Carbon 15 pistol types; Rock River Arms, Inc.
16 Standard A2, Car A2, Standard A4 Flattop, Car Flattop, NM A2-DCM
17 Legal or LE Tactical Carbine types; Special Weapons SW-5/45 type;

- 18 Wilson Combat AR-15, Urban Tactical, Tactical Precision and Tactical
19 Carbine types.

Statement of Purpose:

To expand the definition of assault weapon to include additional named weapons and weapon characteristics.
