**AN ACT CONCERNING APPLICATION CRITERIA FOR A PERMIT TO  
CARRY A PISTOL OR REVOLVER.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

1 That subdivision (5) of subsection (b) of section 29-28 of the general  
2 statutes be amended to provide that no state or temporary state permit  
3 to carry a pistol or revolver be issued to an applicant who has been  
4 confined in a hospital for persons with psychiatric disabilities, as  
5 defined in section 17a-495 of the general statutes, within the preceding  
6 sixty months by order of a probate court, instead of the prior twelve  
7 months as currently provided.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To extend the look-back period for certain application criteria for a  
permit to carry a pistol or revolver.
