**AN ACT CONCERNING THE KNOWLEDGE TEST REQUIRED FOR  
ISSUANCE OF A MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATOR'S LICENSE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Commissioner
- 2 of Motor Vehicles to include thirty-five questions on the knowledge
- 3 test taken by applicants for a motor vehicle operator's license and to
- 4 provide that any such applicant who answers twenty-five or more of
- 5 such questions correctly shall receive a passing score on such test.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To provide that twenty-five or more correct answers to thirty-five questions shall constitute a passing score on the motor vehicle operator's license knowledge test.
