AN ACT ALLOWING THE USE OF GOLF CARTS ON LOCAL ROADS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to allow the traffic authority
2 of any city, town or borough to permit the use of golf carts, during
3 daylight hours, on any street or highway under the jurisdiction of such
4 traffic authority, provided (1) such golf cart is equipped with an
5 operable horn in accordance with subsection (e) of section 14-80 of the
6 general statutes, (2) such golf cart is equipped with a flag that is
7 positioned to assist any operator of a motor vehicle to observe the
8 location and operation of such golf cart, (3) no such golf cart operates
9 on any street or highway with a posted speed limit greater than
10 twenty-five miles per hour, and (4) the operator of such golf cart
11 carries a valid motor vehicle operator's license while operating such
12 golf cart.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow the use of golf carts on local roads under certain circumstances.
