AN ACT CONCERNING CONSUMER PROTECTION OF CABLE TELEVISION AND VIDEO SERVICE CUSTOMERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Public Utilities Regulatory
2 Authority shall initiate a docket to evaluate additional consumer
3 protections for customers of holders of a certificate of cable franchise
4 authority, as defined in section 16-1 of the general statutes, and holders
5 of a certificate of video franchise authority, as defined in section 16-1 of
6 the general statutes, including, but not limited to, customer notification
7 of pricing changes. On or before January 1, 2014, the authority shall
8 report the findings of such docket to the joint standing committee of
9 the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to energy,
10 in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general
11 statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
