**AN ACT CONCERNING THE DISCLOSURE OF THE USE OF
CONFLICT MINERALS AND STATE PROCUREMENT AND
INVESTMENT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit (1) state agencies
- 2 from procuring supplies or personal services from companies that fail
- 3 to disclose whether they use conflict minerals originating in the
- 4 Democratic Republic of the Congo in accordance with the Dodd-Frank
- 5 Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act, and (2) the
- 6 Treasurer from investing state funds in companies that fail to make
- 7 such disclosure.

Statement of Purpose:

To reduce armed conflict in the Democratic Republic of the Congo.
