**AN ACT CONCERNING OUT-OF-STATE RESIDENTS AND  
UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require individuals residing
- 2 outside of the state of Connecticut that are eligible for and receiving
- 3 unemployment benefits administered through the state of Connecticut
- 4 to document and submit to the administrator, on a monthly basis,
- 5 written verification that such individual has applied for and actively
- 6 sought suitable work during the previous month.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To require out-of-state residents receiving state unemployment compensation to produce proof of job search.
