***AN ACT REPEALING THE REQUIREMENT THAT BOARDS OF EDUCATION BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PRESCHOOL TUITION PAYMENTS.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That sections 10-264l and 10-264o of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to repeal the requirement that local and regional boards of
- 3 education be responsible for paying any tuition charged for students
- 4 enrolled in a preschool program offered at an interdistrict magnet
- 5 school or a charter school.

***Statement of Purpose:***

To repeal the requirement that local and regional boards of education are responsible for paying preschool program tuition at magnet schools and charter schools.
