**AN ACT EXCLUDING VETERANS' DISABILITY COMPENSATION
FROM PROPERTY ASSIGNMENT AND ALIMONY IN DISSOLUTION
OF MARRIAGE PROCEEDINGS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That sections 46b-81 and 46b-82 of the general statutes be amended
- 2 to provide that, in determining orders for alimony or property
- 3 assignment in an action for marital dissolution, annulment or legal
- 4 separation, the Superior Court shall exclude from consideration any
- 5 amount of disability compensation received by either party from the
- 6 United States Department of Veterans Affairs.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure that income a veteran receives from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs as disability compensation is not subject to an alimony or property assignment order in an action for marital dissolution, annulment or legal separation.
