**AN ACT CONCERNING THE CREATION OF A REGIONAL
ALTERNATIVE HIGH SCHOOL IN BRIDGEPORT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 164 of the general statutes be amended to create a
- 2 regional alternative high school in Bridgeport that will provide
- 3 academic programs and behavioral and emotional support services to
- 4 high school students who (1) have been involved in the juvenile justice
- 5 system, (2) are behind in high school credits and are in danger of not
- 6 graduating, or (3) are twenty-one years of age and have not yet
- 7 graduated.

Statement of Purpose:

To create a regional alternative high school in Bridgeport that will help school districts save money by not having to create individual alternative programs for students.
