**AN ACT CONCERNING PERMITS FOR FILMING ON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION PROPERTY.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2013*) The Commissioner of  
2 Transportation may issue a filming permit, on a form required by the  
3 commissioner, to any person seeking to film upon (1) any state  
4 highway right-of-way, or (2) state real property under the custody and  
5 control of the Department of Transportation. Such permit shall specify  
6 the insurance coverage that the permittee shall be required to obtain,  
7 as determined by the commissioner in consultation with the state's  
8 Director of Insurance and Risk Management, with the state named as  
9 an additional insured. No liability shall accrue to the state or any  
10 agency or employee of the state for any injuries or damages to any  
11 person or property that may result, either directly or indirectly, from  
12 the filming activities of the permittee on state real property or any state  
13 highway right-of-way. The commissioner shall develop any such  
14 permit in collaboration and consultation with the Commissioner of  
15 Economic and Community Development.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

**Statement of Purpose:**

To allow the Department of Transportation, in collaboration with the Department of Economic and Community Development, to design and implement a permitting system for persons seeking to film on state property under the custody and control of the Department of Transportation.
