**AN ACT CONCERNING ELECTRONIC BILL SIGNATURES BY LEGISLATORS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Joint Committee on Legislative
- 2 Management shall study the feasibility of developing a process that
- 3 would allow a legislator to electronically sign a bill to be filed with the
- 4 clerk of the Senate or House of Representatives. On or before January
- 5 1, 2014, said committee shall report the findings of such study to the
- 6 joint standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance
- 7 of matters relating to technology.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
