AN ACT CONCERNING CHILDREN AND BEHAVIORAL HEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2013*) The joint standing committee of the
2 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to children
3 shall conduct a study to evaluate the effectiveness of the current
4 behavioral health support system available to children throughout the
5 state. The committee shall report, in accordance with the provisions of
6 section 11-4a of the general statutes, the findings of the study to the
7 General Assembly on or before February 1, 2014.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
