**RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE STATE
CONSTITUTION CONCERNING TERM LIMITS FOR STATE-WIDE
ELECTED OFFICIALS AND MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL
ASSEMBLY.**

Resolved by this Assembly:

- 1 That section 2 of article fourth of the state Constitution be amended
- 2 to provide that no Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of the
- 3 State, Treasurer, Comptroller or Attorney General shall serve more
- 4 than two terms and that section 10 of article third of the state
- 5 Constitution be amended to provide that no senator or representative
- 6 shall serve more than five terms in such office.

Statement of Purpose:

To limit the number of terms for elected officials.
