***RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE
CONSTITUTION TO FORM A UNICAMERAL LEGISLATURE.***

Resolved by this Assembly:

- 1 That article third of the Constitution of the state be amended to
- 2 replace the General Assembly with a unicameral legislature composed
- 3 of sixty members who shall have rotating four and two-year terms,
- 4 effective for the first election after the decennial census in 2022.

Statement of Purpose:

To save money, end redundant and duplicative representation, create a more contemplative legislature, and make the legislature more broad based.
