I strongly urge you to consider ticket refunds/replacements in the event of canceled service per HB5127 for weekly and monthly ticket holders. It is unfair for commuters to pay for a ticket for ridership and then lose out on this paid ticket for service when the trains do not run. I believe ticket prices fund for any "out of service costs" associated with Metro North, therefore, asking commuters to buy two tickets rather than one is not just.

It's basic, we pay a fee for service; if those services are not made available then the cost associated for that service should not apply!
