My husband and I are deeply against establishing tolls on our border. We live on a state road and during the period of time when the vehicle checks and weigh station checks at Exit 2 on Interstate 84 were happening, we had many 18 wheelers bypassing these stops by using our local state road (Milltown Road in Danbury/New Fairfield).

Many times we would see multiple trucks barreling down our roads as early as 4:00 in the morning. And they certainly didn't drive the required 35 mph posted. My fear for the tolls is that commercial traffic would bypass these by exiting in NY state on Route 22 and use Milltown Road and Route 39 in Danbury as a way in which to circumvent the tolls and/or weigh station process.

This happened during the period following 9/11 and continued on while the weigh stations were been used on a regular basis.
