"AN ACT CONCERNING PROVISIONAL BALLOTS FOR STATE AND MUNICIPAL OFFICES."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsections (g) and (h) of section 9-19j of the general
4 statutes are repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof
5 (*Effective from passage*):

6 (g) The elector shall forthwith mark the election day registration
7 ballot in the presence of the registrars of voters in such a manner that
8 the registrars of voters shall not know how the election day
9 registration ballot is marked. The elector shall place the election day
10 registration ballot in the election day registration ballot envelope
11 provided, and deposit such envelope in a secured election day
12 registration ballot depository receptacle. [At the time designated by the
13 registrars of voters and noticed to election officials, the registrars of
14 voters shall transport such receptacle containing the election day
15 registration ballots to the area, either district or central, where absentee

16 ballots are counted and such election day registration ballots shall be
 17 counted by the election officials present at such location.] The
 18 provisions of the general statutes and regulations concerning the
 19 counting of provisional ballots shall apply as nearly as possible to the
 20 counting of election day registration ballots under this subsection. A
 21 section of the head moderator's return shall show the number of
 22 election day registration ballots received from electors. The registrars
 23 of voters shall seal a copy of the vote tally for election day registration
 24 ballots in a depository envelope with the election day registration
 25 ballots and store such election day registration depository envelope
 26 with the other election results materials. The election day registration
 27 depository envelope shall be preserved by the registrars of voters for
 28 the period of time required to preserve counted ballots for elections.

29 (h) The provisions of the general statutes and regulations
 30 concerning procedures relating to the custody [,] and control [and
 31 counting] of absentee ballots shall apply as nearly as possible, to the
 32 custody [,] and control [and counting] of election day registration
 33 ballots under subsections (a) to (i), inclusive, of this section."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
