4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
5 *October 1, 2013*):

20 dollars; (11) [filing certificate of dissolution, fifty dollars; (12)] filing
21 certificate of revocation of dissolution, fifty dollars; [(13)] (12) filing
22 annual report, one hundred fifty dollars except as otherwise provided
23 in sections 33-953 and 33-954; [(14)] (13) filing application of foreign
24 corporation for certificate of authority to transact business in this state
25 and issuing certificate of authority, one hundred dollars; [(15)] (14)
26 filing application of foreign corporation for amended certificate of
27 authority to transact business in this state and issuing amended
28 certificate of authority, one hundred dollars; [(16) filing application for
29 withdrawal of foreign corporation and issuing certificate of

86 filing articles of organization, including appointment of statutory
87 agent, one hundred twenty dollars; (4) filing change of address of
88 statutory agent or change of statutory agent, fifty dollars; (5) filing
89 notice of resignation of statutory agent in duplicate, fifty dollars; (6)
90 filing amendment to articles of organization, one hundred twenty
91 dollars; (7) filing restated articles of organization, one hundred twenty
92 dollars; (8) filing articles of merger or consolidation, sixty dollars; (9)

130 fees and remit them to the Treasurer for the use of the state: (1) For
131 filing of an application for reservation of name, and application for
132 renewal of reservation, or notice of transfer or cancellation of
133 reservation pursuant to section 34-506, sixty dollars; (2) for filing of a
134 certificate of trust, a certificate of amendment [,] or a restated certificate
135 of trust, [or a certificate of cancellation,] one hundred twenty dollars;
136 (3) for preparing and furnishing a copy of any certificate filed relating
137 to a statutory trust: For each copy of each such document thereof
138 regardless of the number of pages, forty dollars; for affixing his
139 certification thereto, fifteen dollars; (4) for preparing and furnishing a
140 certificate of existence or authorization, forty dollars; (5) for preparing
141 and furnishing a certificate of existence or authorization reflecting any
142 and all changes of name and the date or dates of filing thereof, eighty
143 dollars; (6) for filing of a certificate of merger or consolidation, sixty
144 dollars; and (7) for other services for which fees are not provided by
145 the general statutes, the Secretary of the State may charge such fees as
146 will in his judgment cover the cost of the services provided."
