**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE AUTHORITY OF FIRE CHIEFS AT CERTAIN STATE FACILITIES."**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the  
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2013*) Notwithstanding section  
4 7-313e of the general statutes or any other provision of the general  
5 statutes, or any provision of a municipal ordinance, the fire chief of the  
6 fire department at The University of Connecticut at Storrs, The  
7 University of Connecticut Health Center or the Southbury Training  
8 School, or any member of such department serving in the capacity of  
9 fire officer-in-charge, shall, whenever any fire department or company  
10 is responding to or operating at a fire, service call or other emergency  
11 at said university, health center or training school, (1) control and direct  
12 emergency activities at such scene, (2) order any person to leave any  
13 building or place in the vicinity of such fire, service call or emergency  
14 for the purpose of protecting such person from injury, and (3) have all  
15 other authority provided to a fire chief or fire officer-in-charge

16 pursuant to section 7-313e of the general statutes.

17 Sec. 2. Section 15-101ww of the general statutes is repealed and the  
18 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2013*):

19 Notwithstanding section 7-313e or any other provision of the  
20 general statutes, or any provision of a municipal ordinance, the fire  
21 chief of the fire department at Bradley International Airport, or any  
22 member serving in the capacity of the fire officer-in-charge shall, when  
23 any fire department or company is responding to or operating at a fire,  
24 service call or other emergency at Bradley International Airport, (1)  
25 control and direct emergency activities at such scene, (2) order any  
26 person to leave any building, aircraft or place in the vicinity of such  
27 fire for the purpose of protecting such person from injury, and (3) have  
28 all other authority provided to a fire chief or a fire officer-in-charge  
29 pursuant to section 7-313e."
