"AN ACT CONCERNING GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION."

1 Strike sections 1 to 3, inclusive, and renumber the remaining
2 sections and internal references accordingly

3 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
4 internal references accordingly:

5 "Sec. 501. Section 5-228 of the general statutes is repealed and the
6 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

7 (a) When a vacancy in any permanent position in the classified
8 service is to be filled, the appointing authority shall notify the
9 Commissioner of Administrative Services of such fact, stating the title
10 of the position to be filled. Vacancies in such positions shall be filled,
11 so far as [practicable] possible and for the best interest of the state, by
12 reemployment, as provided in subsection (b) of section 5-241,

13 promotional appointments from within the agency and service-wide
14 promotional appointments or transfers in accordance with regulations
15 issued by the commissioner. The appointing authority, with the
16 approval of the commissioner, shall decide whether a vacancy shall be
17 filled by promotion from within the agency, from a state-wide
18 employment list, transfer or, if such is not [practicable] possible, by
19 original appointment.

20 (b) If a vacancy is to be filled by a promotional appointment from
21 within the agency, the commissioner shall certify to the appointing
22 authority the names of all candidates from the agency in accordance
23 with the provisions of section 5-215a.

24 (c) If a vacancy is to be filled by promotion from a service-wide
25 candidate list, the commissioner shall certify to the appointing
26 authority the names of all candidates on that candidate list in
27 accordance with the provisions of section 5-215a.

28 (d) If a vacancy is to be filled by an original appointment, the
29 commissioner shall certify to the appointing authority the names of all
30 candidates on that candidate list in accordance with the provisions of
31 section 5-215a.

32 (e) Appointees to any position in the classified service shall be
33 required to serve the working test period provided for in this chapter.
34 Any promotional appointee from within the agency who is dismissed
35 from the position to which [he] such appointee was promoted during
36 such working test period, or at the conclusion thereof, shall be restored
37 to a position in the same class in which [he] the appointee had been
38 employed prior to his or her promotion. Any other appointee who was
39 employed in the classified service prior to his or her appointment and
40 who is dismissed from the position to which he or she was appointed
41 during such working test period or at the conclusion thereof, shall be
42 restored to a vacancy in the same class, or a vacancy in a comparable
43 class or a vacancy in any other position the employee is qualified to
44 fill, in the agency in which he or she had been employed prior to his or

45 her appointment, or shall have his or her name placed on a
 46 reemployment list. No appointing authority who has removed such an
 47 employee as provided in this section may exercise such right of
 48 removal again with respect to any other employee in the same position
 49 within three calendar months after such original removal, except with
 50 the consent of the commissioner. No provision of this section shall be
 51 construed to prevent any employee in the unclassified service from
 52 competing for positions in the classified service if [he] such employee
 53 possesses the minimum qualifications established by the
 54 commissioner, [, except that no such employee shall be eligible to
 55 compete in a promotional examination unless he has previous
 56 permanent status in classified service.] In the certification of names of
 57 persons eligible for appointment, sex shall be disregarded except when
 58 otherwise provided by statute or upon request of the appointing
 59 authority subject to the approval of the commissioner.

60 Sec. 502. (*Effective from passage*) The General Assembly shall
 61 commemorate the fourteenth anniversary of the Connecticut-Taiwan
 62 sister state relationship. Suitable exercises shall be held in the State
 63 Capitol and elsewhere as the General Assembly designates for such
 64 commemoration."
