"AN ACT IMPLEMENTING THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE PROGRAM REVIEW AND INVESTIGATIONS COMMITTEE CONCERNING THE CREATION OF A GOVERNANCE STRUCTURE TO IMPLEMENT E-GOVERNMENT."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. Section 4d-12 of the general statutes is repealed and the
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2013*):

5 (a) The Commissioner of Administrative Services may establish
6 such committees as he deems necessary to advise the commissioner in
7 carrying out the purposes of sections 4d-1 to 4d-5, inclusive, section
8 4d-7 and sections 4d-11 to 4d-14, inclusive.

9 (b) There is established an information and telecommunication
10 systems executive steering committee consisting of the following
11 members or their designees: The Commissioner of Administrative
12 Services, the Secretary of the State and the Secretary of the Office of

13 Policy and Management [, the Comptroller, the Treasurer and the
14 chairperson of the board of trustees of each constituent unit of the state
15 system of higher education, or their designees] and not more than four
16 other members who are commissioners of an executive branch state
17 agency, appointed jointly by the Commissioner of Administrative
18 Services and the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management.
19 The Commissioner of Administrative Services, or a designee, shall
20 serve as chairperson of the committee. The Department of
21 Administrative Services shall serve as staff to the committee. The
22 committee shall (1) review and approve or disapprove the annual
23 information and telecommunication systems strategic plan developed
24 under section 4d-7, state agency estimates of expenditure requirements
25 for information and telecommunication systems established under
26 section 4d-11, and major telecommunication initiatives, (2) review, in
27 consultation with the Department of Administrative Services, and
28 approve or disapprove variances to (A) the list of approved
29 architectural components for information and telecommunication
30 systems for state agencies, (B) the strategic plan, and (C)
31 appropriations for information and telecommunication systems, and
32 (3) advise the Department of Administrative Services on the
33 organization and functions of the department in regards to
34 information and telecommunication systems. The committee shall
35 submit a report on each approved variance to the General Assembly,
36 in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a. Such report shall
37 include the reasons for the variance and the results of a cost-benefit
38 analysis on the variance.

39 Sec. 2. Section 4d-14 of the general statutes is repealed and the
40 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2013*):

41 (a) Not later than October first, annually, the Secretary of the Office
42 of Policy and Management shall submit to the Governor and the
43 General Assembly, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a,
44 (1) the updated strategic plan established under section 4d-7, and (2) a
45 report on the activities of the Department of Administrative Services

46 and cost savings and improvements in the efficiency of information
47 and telecommunication systems of state agencies, which are
48 attributable to the efforts of said department.

49 (b) Not later than October first, annually, the commissioner shall
50 submit a report, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a, to
51 the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management, the Governor
52 and the joint standing committees of the General Assembly having
53 cognizance of matters relating to appropriations and the budgets of
54 state agencies and government administration and the Legislative
55 Program Review and Investigations Committee, (1) specifying the
56 actual expenditures of each state agency for the last completed fiscal
57 year for information and telecommunication systems, (2) identifying
58 all technology projects on which the Division of Information
59 Technology is working or that the division plans to undertake, (3)
60 identifying the efforts of the Division of Information Technology and
61 of executive branch state agencies to use e-government solutions to
62 deliver state services and conduct state programs, including the
63 feedback and demands of clients of such agencies received by such
64 agencies and such agencies' plans to address client concerns by using
65 online solutions, when determined feasible by such agencies, (4)
66 specifying potential opportunities for increasing the efficiency or
67 reducing the costs of the state's information and telecommunication
68 systems, and [(4) including] (5) outlining a plan to realize such
69 opportunities.

70 (c) Each state agency shall submit to the Commissioner of
71 Administrative Services all plans, documents and other information
72 requested by the commissioner for the development of the report
73 described in subsection (b) of this section."
