**"AN ACT CONCERNING GUN VIOLENCE PREVENTION AND CHILDREN'S SAFETY."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) Any person who earned risk  
4 reduction credit toward a reduction in such person's sentence under  
5 the provisions of section 18-98e of the general statutes, revision of 1958,  
6 revised to 2013, prior to the effective date of this section shall forfeit  
7 such credit, except that nothing in this section shall invalidate the  
8 release or parole release of an inmate pursuant to such credit that  
9 occurred prior to the effective date of this section.

10 Sec. 502. Section 18-100c of the general statutes is repealed and the  
11 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

12 A person convicted of a crime who is incarcerated on or after July 1,  
13 1993, who received a definite sentence of two years or less, and who  
14 has been confined under such sentence for not less than one-half of the

15 sentence imposed by the court, less such time as may have been earned  
 16 under the provisions of section 18-7, 18-7a, 18-98a, 18-98b or 18-98d, [or  
 17 less any risk reduction credit earned under the provisions of section  
 18 18-98e,] may be released pursuant to subsection (e) of section 18-100 or  
 19 to any other community correction program approved by the  
 20 Commissioner of Correction.

21 Sec. 503. Section 18-100d of the general statutes is repealed and the  
 22 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

23 Notwithstanding any other provision of the general statutes, any  
 24 person convicted of a crime committed on or after October 1, 1994,  
 25 shall be subject to supervision by personnel of the Department of  
 26 Correction until the expiration of the maximum term or terms for  
 27 which such person was sentenced, [less any risk reduction credit  
 28 earned under the provisions of section 18-98e.]

29 Sec. 504. Section 18-98e of the general statutes is repealed. (*Effective*  
 30 *from passage*)"
