Title: AN ACT CONCERNING UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION BENEFITS FOR SPOUSES OF MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES WHO ARE DEPLOYED OR TRANSFERRED.

Statement of Purpose: To permit an individual to receive unemployment compensation benefits for a period not to exceed two weeks while such individual is relocating with a spouse who is a member of the armed forces and has been transferred or deployed, even if such individual is unavailable for work and unable to make reasonable efforts to obtain work during such period.
