Title: AN ACT CONCERNING NOTICE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CONSUMER PROTECTION OF ALCOHOL-RELATED INCIDENTS INVOLVING INDIVIDUALS UNDER THE AGE OF TWENTY-ONE.
