**Title:** AN ACT IMPLEMENTING THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE LEGISLATIVE PROGRAM REVIEW AND INVESTIGATIONS COMMITTEE CONCERNING THE ASSESSMENT METHODOLOGY FOR THE EXPENDITURES OF THE INSURANCE DEPARTMENT AND THE OFFICE OF THE HEALTHCARE ADVOCATE.

**Statement of Purpose:** To require the Insurance Department to render with its proposed assessments to domestic insurance companies or other domestic entities liable for payment under section 38a-47 of the general statutes for the expenditures of the Insurance Department and the Office of the Healthcare Advocate a statement that includes (1) the most recent total cost of examinations or valuations assessed against the insurance companies or other entities liable to assessment under section 38a-49 or 38a-50 of the general statutes, (2) the amount of such assessment recouped to date, and (3) a clear description of the effect of such recouped amount on the proposed assessment amount.
