Title: AN ACT CONCERNING WATER INFRASTRUCTURE AND CONSERVATION, MUNICIPAL REPORTING REQUIREMENTS AND UNPAID UTILITY ACCOUNTS AT MULTI-FAMILY DWELLINGS.

Statement of Purpose: To promote water conservation and efficient use of the state's water infrastructure, to reorganize the regulation of water companies from the Department of Public Health to the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority, to eliminate the requirement that a municipality providing water service file an annual report, and to address unpaid utility accounts at multi-family dwellings.
