Title: AN ACT CONCERNING THE INTEREST PAID BY THE STATE ON OVERPAYMENTS OF TAXES, VARIOUS CHANGES TO TAX CREDIT PROGRAMS AVAILABLE UNDER THE INSURANCE PREMIUMS TAX AND THE CORPORATION BUSINESS TAX, EXEMPTIONS FROM THE PETROLEUM PRODUCTS GROSS RECEIPTS TAX, AND A STUDY OF THE STRUCTURE OF THE PERSONAL INCOME TAX.

Statement of Purpose: To clarify that sales of cigarettes at the distributor level are deemed retail sales, and to allow the licensed dealer to recoup the sales tax it paid to the distributor; to provide that interest on an overpayment of the public services companies tax, estate tax, petroleum products gross earnings tax or gift tax will accrue beginning on the ninety-first day following the date of the return or amended return; and to amend the petroleum products gross earnings tax to exempt cosmetic grade mineral oil from the tax and to include as eligible for the credit against said tax a company importing a petroleum product into the state that uses or incorporates a petroleum product into a product that falls under the NAICS section of paint, coating and adhesive manufacturing.
