**Title:** AN ACT CONCERNING THE TAXATION OF DIGITAL DOWNLOADS, BOATS AND MARIJUANA, AND EXPANDING THE TAX CREDITS AVAILABLE UNDER THE NEIGHBORHOOD ASSISTANCE ACT.

**Statement of Purpose:** To impose sales and use tax on specified digital products, except for those sold or purchased in a business-to-business transaction, to repeal the luxury tax on the sale of boats costing over one hundred thousand dollars, to provide a tax credit under the Neighborhood Assistance Act to organizations providing assistance in distressed municipalities, to add "pain" to the definition of "debilitating medical condition" for purposes of the palliative use of marijuana, and to impose a tax on each pound of marijuana provided to a licensed dispensary.
