- 1 Strike lines 1 to 9, inclusive, in their entirety
 - 2 In line 16, before "for" insert an opening bracket
 - 3 In line 18, strike the opening bracket
 - 4 Strike lines 22 and 23 in their entirety and substitute the following in
 - 5 lieu thereof: "activity] that any elector eligible to vote at a primary or
 - 6 an election and any person eligible to vote at a referendum may vote
 - 7 by absentee ballot if he or she is unable to appear at his or her polling
 - 8 place on the day of a primary, an election or a referendum."
 - 9 Strike lines 24 to 91, inclusive, and insert the following in lieu
 - 10 thereof:

11 "RESOLVED: That the foregoing proposed amendment to the
12 Constitution be continued to the next session of the General Assembly
13 elected at the general election to be held on November 4, 2014, and
14 published with the laws passed at the present session, or be presented
15 to the electors at the general election to be held on November 4, 2014,
16 whichever the case may be, according to article sixth of the
17 amendments to the Constitution. The designation of said proposed
18 amendment to be used on ballots at such election shall be "Shall the
19 Constitution of the State be amended to remove restrictions concerning
20 absentee ballots?"
