"AN ACT CONCERNING THE BOARD OF REGENTS FOR HIGHER EDUCATION."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Section 5-198 of the general statutes is repealed and the
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2013*):

5 The offices and positions filled by the following-described
6 incumbents shall be exempt from the classified service:

7 (1) All officers and employees of the Judicial Department;

8 (2) All officers and employees of the Legislative Department;

9 (3) All officers elected by popular vote;

10 (4) All agency heads, members of boards and commissions and
11 other officers appointed by the Governor;

12 (5) All persons designated by name in any special act to hold any
13 state office;

14 (6) All officers, noncommissioned officers and enlisted men in the
15 military or naval service of the state and under military or naval
16 discipline and control;

17 (7) (A) All correctional wardens, as provided in section 18-82, and
18 (B) all superintendents of state institutions, the State Librarian, the
19 president of The University of Connecticut and any other
20 commissioner or administrative head of a state department or
21 institution who is appointed by a board or commission responsible by
22 statute for the administration of such department or institution;

23 (8) The State Historian appointed by the State Library Board;

24 (9) Deputies to the administrative head of each department or
25 institution designated by statute to act for and perform all of the duties
26 of such administrative head during such administrative head's absence
27 or incapacity;

28 (10) Executive assistants to each state elective officer and each
29 department head, as defined in section 4-5, provided each position of
30 executive assistant shall have been created in accordance with section
31 5-214;

32 (11) One personal secretary to the administrative head and to each
33 undersecretary or deputy to such head of each department or
34 institution provided any classified employee whose position is affected
35 by this subsection shall retain classified status in such position;

36 [(12) All members of the professional and technical staffs of the
37 constituent units of the state system of higher education, as defined in
38 section 10a-1, of all other state institutions of learning, of the Board of
39 Regents for Higher Education, and of the agricultural experiment
40 station at New Haven, professional and managerial employees of the
41 Department of Education and teachers certified by the State Board of

- 42 Education and employed in teaching positions at state institutions;]
- 43 [(13)] (12) Physicians, dentists, student nurses in institutions and
44 other professional specialists who are employed on a part-time basis;
- 45 [(14)] (13) Persons employed to make or conduct a special inquiry,
46 investigation, examination or installation;
- 47 [(15)] (14) Students in educational institutions who are employed on
48 a part-time basis;
- 49 [(16)] (15) Forest fire wardens provided for by section 23-36;
- 50 [(17)] (16) Patients or inmates of state institutions who receive
51 compensation for services rendered therein;
- 52 [(18)] (17) Employees of the Governor including employees working
53 at the executive office, official executive residence at 990 Prospect
54 Avenue, Hartford and the Washington D.C. office;
- 55 [(19)] (18) Persons filling positions expressly exempted by statute
56 from the classified service;
- 57 [(20)] (19) Librarians employed by the State Board of Education or
58 any constituent unit of the state system of higher education;
- 59 [(21)] (20) All officers and employees of the Division of Criminal
60 Justice;
- 61 [(22)] (21) Professional employees in the education professions
62 bargaining unit of the Department of Rehabilitation Services;
- 63 [(23)] (22) Lieutenant colonels in the Division of State Police within
64 the Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection
65 appointed on or after June 6, 1990;
- 66 [(24)] (23) The Deputy State Fire Marshal within the Department of
67 Construction Services;

68 [(25)] (24) The chief administrative officer of the Workers'
69 Compensation Commission;

70 [(26)] (25) Employees in the education professions bargaining unit;

71 [(27)] (26) Disability policy specialists employed by the Council on
72 Developmental Disabilities; and

73 [(28)] (27) The director for digital media and motion picture
74 activities in the Department of Economic and Community
75 Development."
