**"AN ACT CONCERNING WIRELESS BROADBAND."**

1      After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2      internal references accordingly:

3      "Sec. 501. Subsection (d) of section 16-50x of the general statutes is  
4      repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July*  
5      *1, 2013*):

6      (d) Any town, city or borough zoning commission and inland  
7      wetland agency may regulate and restrict the proposed location of a  
8      facility, as defined in subdivisions (3), [and] (4) and (6) of subsection  
9      (a) of section 16-50i. Such local bodies may make all orders necessary  
10     to the exercise of such power to regulate and restrict, which orders  
11     shall be in writing and recorded in the records of their respective  
12     communities, and written notice of any order shall be given to each  
13     party affected thereby. Such a local body shall make any such order (1)  
14     not more than sixty-five days after an application has been filed with  
15     the council for the siting of a facility described in subdivision (3) of

16 subsection (a) of section 16-50i, [or] (2) not more than thirty days after  
 17 an application has been filed with the council for the siting of a facility  
 18 described in subdivision (4) of subsection (a) of section 16-50i, or (3)  
 19 not more than sixty days after an application has been filed with the  
 20 council for the siting of a facility, as defined in subdivision (6) of  
 21 subsection (a) of section 16-50i. Each such order, except an order  
 22 concerning a facility, as defined in subdivision (6) of subsection (a) of  
 23 section 16-50i, shall be subject to the right of appeal within thirty days  
 24 after the giving of such notice by any municipality required to be  
 25 served with a copy of the application under subdivision (1) of  
 26 subsection (b) of section 16-50l or by any party aggrieved to the  
 27 council, which shall have jurisdiction, in the course of any proceeding  
 28 on an application for a certificate or otherwise, to affirm, modify or  
 29 revoke such order or make any order in substitution thereof by a vote  
 30 of six members of the council."
