"AN ACT CONCERNING CHILDREN IN THE JUVENILE JUSTICE SYSTEM."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (b) of section 4-165 of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
5 *October 1, 2013*):

6 (b) For the purposes of this section, (1) "scope of employment"
7 includes but is not limited to, (A) representation by an attorney
8 appointed by the Public Defender Services Commission as a public
9 defender, assistant public defender or deputy assistant public defender
10 or an attorney appointed by the court as Division of Public Defender
11 Services assigned counsel or guardian ad litem of an indigent accused
12 or of a child on a petition of delinquency, (B) representation by such

13 other attorneys, referred to in section 4-141, of state officers and
 14 employees in actions brought against such officers and employees in
 15 their official and individual capacities, (C) the discharge of duties as a
 16 trustee of the state employees retirement system, (D) the discharge of
 17 duties of a commissioner of the Superior Court hearing small claims
 18 matters or acting as a fact-finder, arbitrator or magistrate or acting in
 19 any other quasi-judicial position, (E) the discharge of duties of a
 20 person appointed to a committee established by law for the purpose of
 21 rendering services to the Judicial Department, including, but not
 22 limited to, the Legal Specialization Screening Committee, the State-
 23 Wide Grievance Committee, the Client Security Fund Committee, the
 24 advisory committee appointed pursuant to section 51-81d and the
 25 State Bar Examining Committee, (F) military duty performed by the
 26 armed forces of the state while under state active duty, and (G)
 27 representation by an individual appointed by the Public Defender
 28 Services Commission, or by the court, as a guardian ad litem or
 29 attorney for a party in a neglect, abuse, termination of parental rights,
 30 delinquency or family with service needs proceeding; provided the
 31 actions described in subparagraphs (A) to (G), inclusive, of this
 32 subdivision arise out of the discharge of the duties or within the scope
 33 of employment of such officers or employees, and (2) "state employee"
 34 includes a member or employee of the soil and water district boards
 35 established pursuant to section 22a-315.
