"AN ACT CONCERNING THE SAFETY OF WORKERS IN ROADWAY WORK ZONES."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (a) of section 14-212d of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July*
5 *1, 2013*):

6 (a) As used in this section and section 14-212e: (1) "Highway work
7 zone" means an area of a state highway, or a local highway, as defined
8 in section 14-212b, where construction, maintenance or utility work is
9 being performed. Such work zone shall be marked by signs,
10 channeling devices, barriers, pavement markings or work vehicles, and
11 extends from the first warning sign or high-intensity rotating, flashing,
12 oscillating or strobe lights on a vehicle to the "END ROAD WORK"
13 sign or the last temporary traffic control device; and (2) "highway
14 worker" means a person who is required to perform the duties of such
15 person's job on state bridges, state roads or in highway work zones,

16 including: (A) A person who performs maintenance, repair or
 17 construction of state bridges, state roads, shoulders, medians and
 18 associated rights-of-way in highway work zones; (B) a person who
 19 operates a truck, loader or other equipment on state bridges, state roads
 20 or in highway work zones; (C) a person who performs any other related
 21 maintenance work, as required, on state bridges, state roads or in
 22 highway work zones; (D) a state or local public safety officer who
 23 enforces work zone-related transportation management and traffic
 24 control; (E) a state or local public safety officer who conducts traffic
 25 control or enforcement operations on state bridges, state roads,
 26 shoulders, medians and associated rights-of-way; and (F) a state or
 27 local public safety officer or firefighter, an emergency medical services
 28 provider, or any other authorized person, who removes hazards from
 29 state bridges, state roadways, shoulders, medians and associated
 30 rights-of-way, or who responds to accidents and other incidents on
 31 state bridges, state roads, shoulders, medians, associated rights-of-way
 32 or in highway work zones."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
